Welcome to the December Newsletter, which includes a short review of the 2019 sailing season, information from the 2019 AGM and 2020 club cruises.

2019 Sailing Summary

Easter Cruise

We had two boats on the Easter Cruise; Puck & Modwena. With a late Easter the weather was warm, and the crews had an enjoyable week.

Summer Cruises

The early August bank holiday resulted in three cruise weeks this summer.

First week; Cantley to Wroxham, with Puck, Stella Genesta, Modwena, Pan and Rebecca.

Second week; Wroxham to Beccles, with Puck, Stella Genesta, Modwena, Pan and Rebecca. We also had Leda and Force Four in company.

Third Week; Beccles to Somerleyton, with Puck, Stella Genesta, Modwena, Pan, Rebecca and Sparklet.

As usual, the crews experienced a variety of weather with some great sailing days, some calm days and occasionally very strong winds. There was a gale during week one, when the boats had to remain firmly tied up at Hunters yard for a day and a half, and again for the weekend at Beccles the start of week three. The crews generally had a very enjoyable time whether on the water or alongside, and some terrific barbecues.

There were 12 first timers this year, 16 promotions and 15 RYA qualifications were awarded. Well done to all involved.

Club Races

There were 25 entries for **The Cecil Howard Memorial Race**, it was great to see the first three places filled by club boats especially with such a large field, Pan finished 1st, Stella Genesta 2nd and Force Four 3rd.

The Round The Island Race was won by Stella Genesta, with Modwena 2nd and Sparklet 3rd.

2019 Annual General Meeting

This year's AGM was held at The Reedcutter Inn, Cantley on Sunday 27th October. It was attended by fourteen members and there were nine apologies.



The main highlights are below:

Commodore Andy Garnham started the meeting with a minutes silence to remember Paul Brierly and Peter Ford who have sadly passed away since the last AGM.

2018 AGM Minutes

These were approved unanimously as an accurate record.

2019 Officers Reports

These had previously been circulated to members, they were reviewed at the AGM and all unanimously accepted.

Motions

There were 2 motions, summarised below (the full wordings were sent out with the AGM Agenda).

Motion 1 was a proposal for first timers to be offered membership after 1 weeks cruise instead of the current 2 weeks.

There was a significant amount of debate on this with differing opinions and an acknowledgement that some of the club rules need to be clarified to ensure consistency.

The commodore brought the debate to a close and a vote was made. The motion fell with 5 in favour and 7 against.

Motion 2 in summary, was to separate Club membership from Club Rank.

The motion was withdrawn.

Those present agreed that a sub committee would be set up to review the rules in order to make them clear and consistent. Any rule changes are to be put in place in time for Summer 2020, with an Extraordinary General Meeting held before the rigging party to review the subcommittee proposals. This was voted on and unanimously agreed.

EGM scheduled for 10th April.

Cruise Fees and Food Money for 2020

It was agreed that cruise fees should remain at £160 per week for early payments, and £180 for payments made less than a month before the first summer cruise starts.

It was agreed that food money should remain at £40 per week.
